

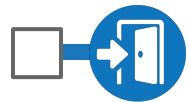

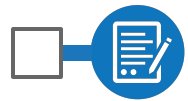

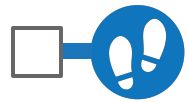

I'M A WOMAN & FAMILY

Austin Shelter for Women & Children is an option for single women or women with children. To get case management, you have to be admitted to the shelter as a resident.

- Call **512-933-0600** to get on the call back list.

ELIGIBILITY

- You are homeless or living in unsustainable Housing, or victim of domestic violence
- You are female head of household (e.g. mother grandmother, two sisters, or two moms with children).
- You are a single female.
- You identify as female.
- No males over 17 years old.
- No unaccompanied minors.

STEPS TO CASE MANAGEMENT

- Call the shelter and get on the call back list.
- When a space opens up come in and do an initial intake.
- Meet with a Case Manager within 48 hours.
- Get tested for tuberculosis (TB) within 7 days of arriving at the shelter.
- If you need an ID or any other basic documents, the shelter will help you.

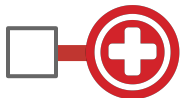
